Fortnightly Selection Statistics – 18 November 2009

1. Selection 18 November 2009– Skilled Migrant Category

The most recent selection of Expressions of Interest (EOIs) under the Skilled Migrant Category took place on **18 November 2009**

- **379** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **140** or above;
- **102** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **100** or more but less than 140, and included points for offers of skilled employment or current skilled employment in New Zealand.
- **41** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **100** or more but less than 140, and included 15 points for work experience in an area of absolute skill shortage.
- **27** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **100** or more but less than 140, and included 10 points for work experience in an area of absolute skill shortage.
- **33** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **100** or more but less than 140, and included 10 points for a qualification in an area of absolute skill shortage.
- **51** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **110** or more but less than 140. These EOIs did not claim points for offers of skilled employment or current skilled employment in New Zealand, work experience in an area of absolute skill shortage or for a qualification in an area of absolute skill shortage. These EOIs were ranked in descending order of points.

As a result, **633** EOIs representing **1429** people were selected and will now undergo preliminary verification to determine if an invitation to apply for residency will be issued.

2. The make-up of selection

Based on the information provided by people who had their EOIs selected, the make-up of the 18 November 2009 selection is as follows:

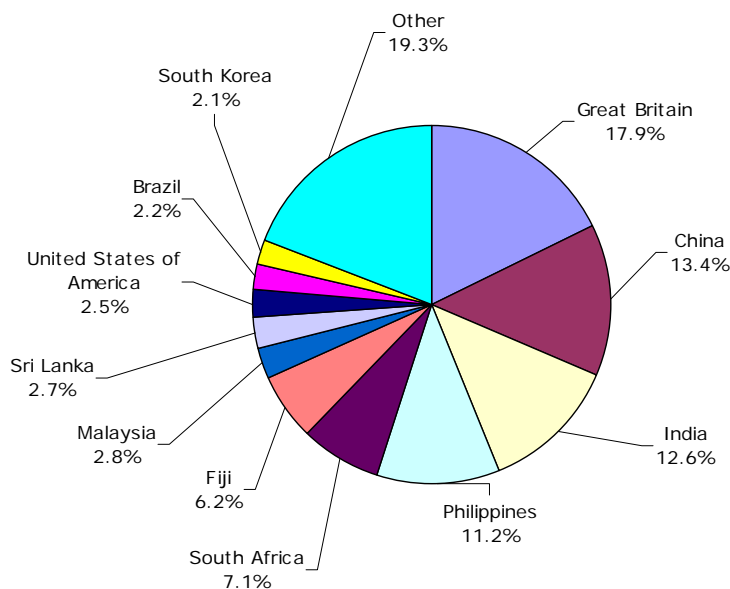

18 November 2009**

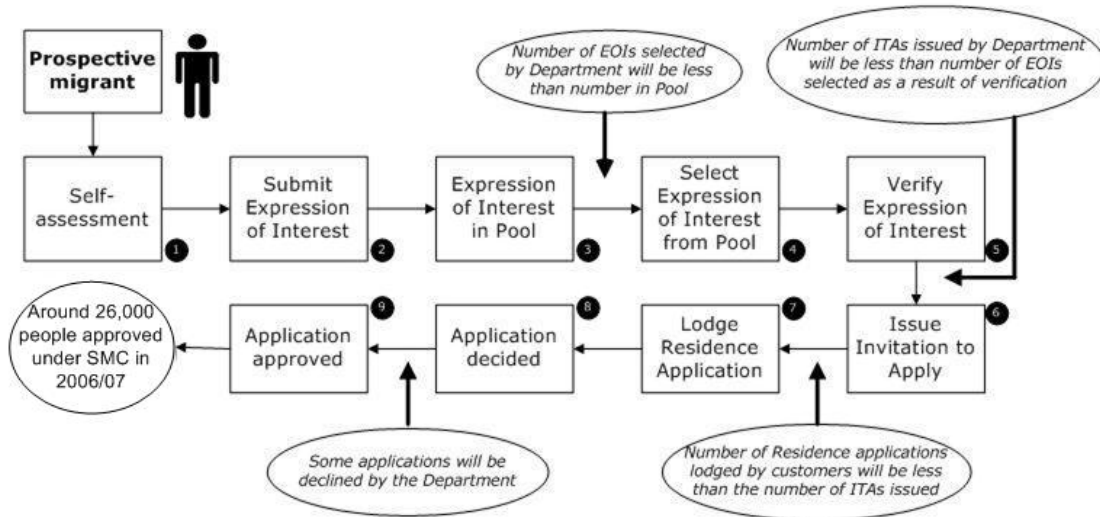


4. Statistics since December 2003

Since the Skilled Migrant Category opened in December 2003, a total of **106,940** EOIs, representing **249,183** people, have been selected

Approximately **96 percent** of those EOIs selected have been verified (stage five below).
