This application is to be forwarded direct to the Officer-in-Charge, CID, Police Headquarters, Suva. The Fiji Police will release this report to Immigration New Zealand in Suva who will forward it to the branch processing your application. Please note the following fees apply and should be included with your application.

- If you are sending this application from within Fiji, the Police fee is F\$61.30.
- If you are sending this application from an overseas country including New Zealand, the Police fee (payable by bank draft only) is F\$102.20 and there is an additional bank fee F\$10.00, total fee F\$112.20.
- If you are paying by international cheque only the Police fee is F\$102.20 with an additional bank fee of F\$50.00, total fee F\$152.20.

Please ensure you enclose a certified copy of your birth certificate and the biodata page of your passport(s).

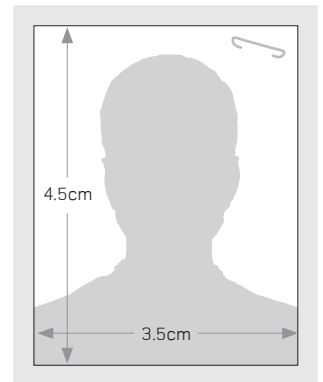
