

eMedical changes: April 2021


As part of the system upgrade, the following changes will be delivered on 10 April 2021.

1- Update to Interpreter section

a. Interpreter question changed (for IRCC, INZ and AUS)

The updated question will now appear for all health cases for the exams where Interpreter section exists.

b. Additional option available for selection (for AUS and INZ only)

A new option '**No – offer declined**' is now available for selection if an interpreter has been offered to the client, but the client has not accepted the offer.




2- Changes to auto addition of exams on a health case (IRCC only)

a. eMedical will now add age appropriate examinations as per table below:

Age	Exam
If the client is under 11 years of age	501 (Medical examination)
If the client is 11 years or older but under 15 years of age	501 (Medical examination) 502 (Chest X-ray examination)
If the client is 15 years or older but under 75 years of age	501 (Medical examination) 502 (Chest X-ray examination) 704 (Serum Creatinine) 707 (HIV) 712 (Syphilis)
If the client is over 75 years of age	501 (Medical examination) 502 (Chest X-ray examination) 704 (Serum Creatinine) 707 (HIV) 712 (Syphilis) 901 (Mini -mental) 903 (Activities of Daily Living)

- **b.** For a UFM health case, if age is changed using 'the Edit case' button, then the required exams will be automatically added/removed as per table above.
- **c.** The rules for auto-addition of examination(s) have been modified. For detailed information, please refer to 'Tip sheet Automatically generated examinations and auto B- grading arrangements' that is available under the Canada Specific folder of the eMedical Support.
- 3- Pre-selected values for some questions in 501 Medical examination (IRCC only)
- a. Basic questions
- Height & Weight

Height percentile and Weight percentile will be pre-selected to Above 3rd percentile.



• Head circumference

Head circumference percentile will be pre-selected to Above 3rd percentile.



Urinalysis exam

Type of test will be pre-selected to Dipstick and Negative for Blood, Glucose and Protein.
