RAISING DIRECTED VISA GRANTS IN AMS

This advice to staff replaces all previous advice relating to how directed visa grants should be raised in AMS.

Last week, CBI One 19 introduced new AMS categories for IPT Orders: Visitor, IPT Order; Work, IPT Order; Student, IPT Order; Limited, IPT Order; and Resident, IPT Order.

Unlawful	DDM/Minister	Temporary or Resident visa	Section 61 of applicable type: Visitor, Section 61 Work, Section 61 Student, Section 61 Resident, Section 61
Unlawful	IPT	Temporary visa under Section 210 or Section 216. IPT orders it. Doesn't go past our Minister.	IPT Order of applicable type: Visitor, IPT Order Work, IPT Order Student, IPT Order Limited, IPT Order
Unlawful	IPT	Resident visa under Section 210. IPT orders it. Doesn't go past our Minister.	Resident, IPT Order
Unlawful	IPT recommends Minister grant it	Resident visa (application declined, appealed, IPT says grant as exception, Minister agrees).	Resident, Section 61
Lawful	DDM/Minister	Resident visa	Resident, Ministerial
Lawful	DDM/Minister	Temporary visa	Whatever the closest application type is, e.g. Student, Full fee paying Visitor, General
Lawful	IPT recommends Minister grant it	Resident visa (application declined, appealed, IPT says grant as exception, Minister agrees)	Resident, Ministerial
